

# Why Supplier Diversity?

#### **General Order 156: Compliance**

- CPUC issued General Order 156 in response to AB 3678 in 2006
- Applies to California Electric, Gas, Water, Wireless Telecommunications service provider, and Telephone corporations- regulated utilities.
- Gross annual revenues exceeding twenty-five million dollars (\$25,000,000)
- Diverse Suppliers Include: Woman-owned, minority-owned, disabled veteran-owned and LGBT-owned business enterprises (WMDVLGBTBEs)
- En Banc: Public CPUC meeting to review CA utility results

#### **CPUC Goal**

- 21.5% utilization of diverse suppliers
  - 15% minority
  - 5% women
  - 1.5% DVBE
- Includes **DIRECT** purchases with
   diverse suppliers
- Includes Primes
   SUBCONTRACTING

   suppliers

### 2nd Tier Contract Requirements

- Contract explains importance of diversity and the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tier Goal
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Tier Subcontractor Tracking Form must be completed prior to final project close out
- Prime Contractor may not know diversity status
- Diversity Manager reviews the submitted documents and rolls up spending to report to PUC
